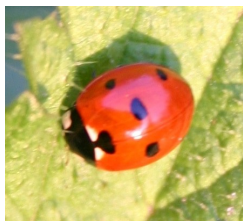

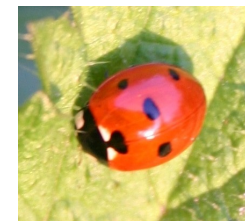
A: Habitats	B: Planting	C: Management
Wildlife Pond in good condition	Wild flower Meadow	Log pile and/or substantial decaying tree stump
Bog or permanently wet area	Long Grass area	Compost Heap
Bird Bath	Nectar rich flower border and bushes	No-go area
Bird Box	Mixed Native Hedge	Climbing plants/ Trellises suitable for nesting and feeding
Bat Box	Mature Native Tree	Slug pellet free
